## WHAT IS THE PUBLIC SCHOOL TAX CREDIT?

If you work in Arizona and pay state taxes, the public school tax credit will save you dollar-for-dollar on the amount of state taxes owed up to the relevant limits (\$200/\$400 for individual/joint filers).

The public school tax credit is available to all Arizona taxpayers regardless of whether you have children in public school or live within the boundaries of the district to which you are contributing.
